

Field Trip - Sample Agenda

Below is a rough idea of a typical first field trip to a golf course. It can be modified depending upon the number of students and topics that the teacher and golf course superintendent wish to cover. Typically, each learning lab lasts 15-20 minutes. Split the class into smaller groups, the teacher(s) are a big help here. We recommend no more than 10 in a group – this results in the best hands-on learning experience for the students.

What	Timing
Arrive, park, and assemble	T-15 min
Begin field trip	T
Introduction to golf course, e.g., history of the club, terrain, stats.	+15 min
Activity – Consult with the teacher(s) and choose three to four labs to cover. A full list of First Green labs can be found on thefirstgreen.org .	+45 min
Conclusion (possible golf activity* on practice green, fill out surveys, snack)	+15
Leave club	
TOTAL TIME	1 hour 30 min

* Golf activity could be a simple putting contest on a practice green. Including a golf activity can extend the field trip time by 15-30 minutes.
